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## How To Use This Lesson Plan

This lesson is all about letter recognition. Actively reading the book first, and to enjoy the whimsical story of Dr. Seuss is a great foundation to the activity. If you choose not to read the book then you can use the activity alone to help your child learn and recognize upper and lowercase letters. There are also letters at the bottom of the photos for extra help. To make this more challenging, you can put a sticker over the letters.

# Introduction

Dr. Seuss books are filled with imagination and wacky characters. Preschoolers will learn letter recognition and matching letter sounds to images with this hands on reading activity.



# Learning Objectives

- Identify images that begin with each letter sound
- Matching corresponding letters

# Materials Needed

- "Dr. Seuss's ABC" Book
- Printable: Puzzle pieces with upper and lowercase letters
- Printable: Images that start with each letter
- Laminator
- Laminating sheets

# Activity Lesson Plan "Dr. Seuss's ABC" Letter and Image Matching Activity

## " Dr. Seuss's ABC" Lesson Activity

**Step 1:** Read the book: " Dr. Seuss's ABC" by Dr. Seuss

**Step 2:** Print out and Laminate the puzzle pieces printable and cut them out along the middle to create two separate pieces

**Step 3:** Print out and laminate the images

**Step 4:** Have preschooler match upper and lowercase letters

**Step 5:** Have preschoolers select the picture that starts with that letter

**Step 6:** While preschooler is matching letters, have them also make short and long letter sounds and name the letters
