In the 2000s fashion was important. Girls wore short dresses and short hair.


Boys wore shorts and t-shirts. Women wore long dresses, long hair and lots of bracelets.

In the 2000s scientist discovered new features of DNA which revolutionised the world of science.




The 1990s by Sheila

She is very good at cooking because she cooks delicious dishes.


She likes taking the dog for a walk on Wednesday and Friday.




