Kilogram(Kg)- hectogram(Hg)- decagram(Dag)- gram(g)- decigram(dg)centigram(cg) -milligram(mg)

-For Capacity/Volume: We use

Kiloliter(KI) -hectolitre(HI) -decaliter(Dal)- liter(I)- deciliter(dI) -centiliter(cI)- milliliter(mI)
