Oral Explanation (Individual)	The student does not know his explanation and reads it and the explanation is too confusing and short 0 points	The student knows his presentation and only reads what is necessary not to get lost, although the explanation is somewhat confusing and short or vice versa 1 point	The student knows his presentation and only reads what is necessary not to get lost, the explanation is adequate although the oral presentation is improvable (does not look at the public, gets too tongue-tied or is not located in a visible place) 3 points	The student knows his presentation and only reads what is necessary not to get lost, the explanation is appropriate and the oral presentation is good (look at the public, do not get too tongue-tied and is in a visible place) 4 points

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
