# PHASE 1: GLOBAL ANALYSIS:

- ▶ **NAME:** Case.
- ▶ **USE:** We used to store pencils.





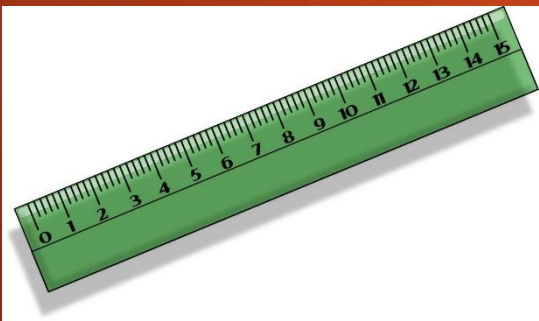
# PHASE 2: ANATOMICAL ANALYSIS:

- ▶ It consists of 2 parts:
- ▶ Zipper and holster.



# PHASE 3: TECHNICAL ANALYSIS:

- ▶ **MEASURE:** You can measure anything because there are different sizes.
- ▶ **WEIGHT:** It depends on the pencils the weight of the case.
- ▶ **MATERIALS:** Plastic and fabric. (Zipper and holster).
- ▶ **COST:** Depends on the case mark and the size.
