# **SLOW FOOD**

Slow food is an international organization that claims "food as pleasure, awareness and responsibility."

It tries to change the way we currently produce, distribute and consume our food. It has more than 100,000 members organized in 1,300 local convivia in 160 countries.

It defends that food must be **good**, **clean** and **fair**.

- Good for the ones who consume them, the ones who produce them and the environment.
- Clean because in the agro-industrial chain biodiversity and sustainability have been preserved.
- Fair because the conditions of work and income of producers, with short distribution chains, are respected.



## ARK OF TASTE

Ark of taste is a slow food program to collect small-scale quality productions of foods that belong to the culture, history and traditions of the entire planet and might be in danger of extinction.

The Ark was created to point out the existence of these products and invite everyone to take action to help protect them.

### Terra Madre

Terra madre is a project created to support the local small and sustainable economy.

There are food producers from 160 different countries, united in 2.000 food communities 1,000 cooks, 450 academics and 1,000 young people. They have a biannual appointment in Turin.
