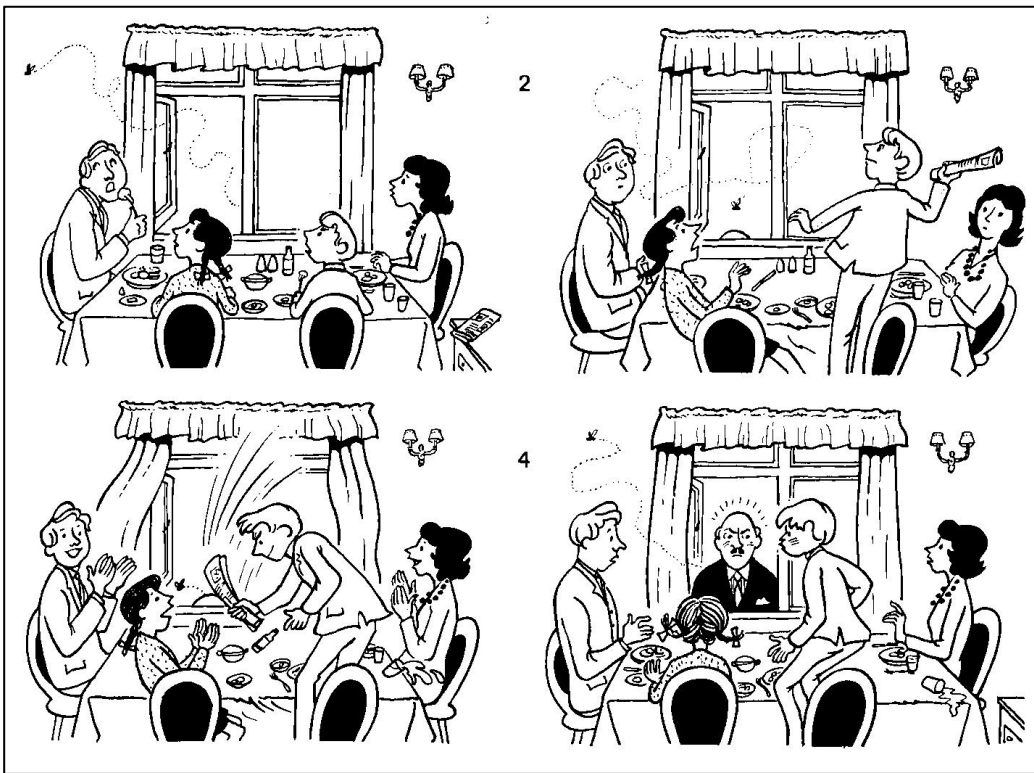


CREATIVE WRITING: PICTURE STORIES

The students write a story to go along with the pictures provided. Even though the pictures are self-explanatory, they should be told to put the pictures into words for someone who has no access to the pictures. Then, they read the stories they have written to other classmates and viceversa.
