
45 MRS GREEN'S FRUIT & VEGETABLE STALL

- 2 The apples are between the lettuce and the sprouts.
- 3 The potatoes are in the same column as the sprouts.
- 1 The oranges are above the cucumbers.
- 2 The sprouts are above the pineapples.
- 3 The cucumbers are on the right of the peaches.


