## USE:

- 1. We use the Present Simple for:
  - regular habits and daily routines;
  - facts, things in general;
  - permanent or long-lasting situations;
  - timetables and schedules.
- 2. It is used with adverbs like:
  - always sometimes every a
  - often rarely ...
  - usually never

### FORM:

- 1. To form the Present Simple we add -s to the infinitive of the verb in the 3rd person singular (he, she, it)
  - E.g.: | live
    - He / She / It lives




